#### **ELECTION OF NEXT EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

#### Background:

The tenure of the Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and the following members of the existing Executive Committee will complete at the 16<sup>th</sup> IFFTI Annual Conference scheduled to be held at Bunka Gakuen University from 27<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2014.

(a)	Americas	-	(i)	Fashion Institute of Technology, USA

(d) Oceanias - (vi) School of Fashion and Textiles, RMIT, Australia

- 2. An additional vacancy has been created in the Oceanias region owing to the merger of two institutions of RMIT.
- 3. The following members will continue on the Executive Committee as their term completes in 2016.
- (a) Americas (b) Asia (i) North Carolina State University, USA
   (ii) Bunka Gakuen University, Japan
- (c) Europe (iii) Amsterdam Fashion Institute, The Netherlands
  - (iv) Institut Français de la Mode, Paris
- 4. The existing rules regarding composition and procedure for election of Executive Committee are summarized below.

#### 5. Composition:

- (a) The Executive Committee comprises Regional Members elected from the four regions of Americas, Europe, Asia and Oceanias. The Chairs of Sub-Committees are preferably elected from amongst the Regional Members. However incase it becomes necessary to elect a Chair of a Sub-Committee from outside the Executive Committee members, then the Chair of that Sub-Committee will be co-opted on the Executive Committee in addition to the Regional Members.
- (b) Based on the spread of membership, it was decided that the representation from the four regions in the Executive Committee will be as follows:—

Americas – 2 Regional Members
 Europe – 3 Regional Members
 Asia – 3 Regional Members
 Oceania – 2 Regional Members
 Total – 10 Regional Members

- (c) Keeping in view the increase in the number of Executive Committee members, and to facilitate cooption of additional suitable members, it was further decided to increase the maximum number of members on the Executive Committee to 15 from the existing 12.
- (d) **Tenure:** The tenure of each Executive Committee member will be four years.
- (e) The replacement of members will be staggered to provide continuity. Hence the change in the Executive Committee will take place by retiring certain member(s) from each region every two years.

#### 6. Procedure:

(a) The Secretary will call for nominations from the General Council for election of additional Regional Members to the next Executive Committee.

- (b) After receiving the nominations, the Secretariat will ask the 'Regular' Members of the General Council to vote to elect additional 'Regional' Members from amongst the nominated institutions.
- (c) The Secretary will table the documents in respect of nominations and voting at the next Executive Committee meeting scheduled to be held at School of Fashion and Textiles, RMIT, Australia on 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> September 2013. The existing Executive Committee will then finalize the composition of new Executive Committee.
- (d) The composition of the new Executive Committee will be communicated to the General Council through the minutes of the 30<sup>th</sup> Executive Committee meeting scheduled to be held at School of Fashion and Textiles, RMIT, Australia.
- (e) The new Executive Committee will convene at the opening session of the Executive Committee meeting scheduled to be held at Bunka Gakuen University, Japan in January, 2014 and elect the Chairperson and the Deputy Chairperson of the new Executive Committee.
- (f) The new Executive Committee will also elect the new Chairs and Deputy Chairs of the Sub-Committees and co-opt additional member(s) to the Executive Committee, if necessary.
- (g) The new Executive Committee will assume office at the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of the General Council scheduled to be held on the next day at Bunka Gakuen University, Japan.



- (b) <u>Regional Meeting:</u> It was agreed to encourage conduct of Regional Meetings as they provided opportunity to include representatives from Member Institutions who would not normally attend the Conferences and could be held to coincide with relevant regional events such as fashion weeks.
- (c) Workshop: The Sub-Committee is to decide the subject for the next Education Initiative Workshop.
