The existing rules regarding composition and procedure for election of Executive Committee are 3. summarized below.

4. Composition:

The Executive Committee comprises Regional Members elected from the four regions of Americas, (a) Europe, Asia and Oceanias. The Chairs of Sub-Committees are preferably elected from amongst the Regional Members. However in case it becomes necessary to elect a Chair of a Sub-Committee from outside the Executive Committee members, then the Chair of that Sub-Committee will be co-opted on the Executive Committee in addition to the Regional Members.

(b) Based on the spread of membership, it was decided that the representation from the four regions in the Executive Committee will be as follows:-

- Americas 2 Regional Members . **3 Regional Members** Europe _
- Asia _ **3 Regional Members**
- Oceania 2 Regional Members _
- Total **10 Regional Members**
- (c) **Tenure:** The tenure of each Executive Committee member will be four years.
- The replacement of members will be staggered to provide continuity. Hence the change in the (d) Executive Committee will take place by retiring certain member(s) from each region every two years.

5. Procedure:

- The Secretary will call for nominations from the General Council for election of additional Regional (a) Members to the next Executive Committee.
- (b) After receiving the nominations, the Secretariat will ask the 'Regular' Members of the General Council to vote to elect additional 'Regional' Members from amongst the nominated institutions.
- (c) The Secretary will table the documents in respect of nominations and voting at the next Executive Committee meeting scheduled to be held at Temasek Polytechnic, Singapore on 28th and 29th October, 2015. The existing Executive Committee will then finalize the composition of new Executive Committee.
- (d) The composition of the new Executive Committee will be communicated to the General Council through the minutes of the 34th Executive Committee meeting scheduled to be held at Temasek Polytechnic, Singapore.

- (e) The new Executive Committee will convene at the opening session of the Executive Committee meeting scheduled to be held at Beijing Institute of Fashion Technology (BIFT), P. R. China in March, 2016 and elect the Chairperson and the Deputy Chairperson of the new Executive Committee.
- (f) The new Executive Committee will also elect the new Chairs and Deputy Chairs of the Sub-Committees and co-opt additional member(s) to the Executive Committee, if necessary.
- (g) The new Executive Committee will assume office at the 18th Annual Meeting of the General Council scheduled to be held on the next day at Beijing Institute of Fashion Technology (BIFT), P. R. China.
