Members to suggest names of companies to be approached. • Approach IAF to involve Industries starting from Europe. • Announce the Conference with Call for Papers and other timelines. • There will be overlap of managing papers for the 2021 and 2022 Conferences. • Pearl Academy to share the proposal with Anne Normoyle, Prof. Anthony Kent and Dr. Dirk Reynders. 4. Membership Fee <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Secretary presented the Financial Status. • It was considered necessary to reduce the subscription for at least 2 years. We may reduce the subscription for 2021 by 50% and for 2022 by 25%.
