IFFTI LOGO USE BRAND GUIDELINES

- The IFFTI logo is an important part of our visual identity and its use should be controlled
- Permission of the IFFTI Secretary must be sought for any individual or Organisation wishing to use the IFFTI logo beyond the Executive Committee
- Any individual or Organisation with permission to use the IFFTI logo should not change or alter the logo in any way, ideally using original artwork files¹
- Approved hosts of previous and forthcoming IFFTI Annual Conferences and/or IFFTI Regional Events may use the logo with additional permission
- As a benefit of membership, IFFTI Member Institutions may use the IFFTI logo without additional permission to promote their Institution, for example in student recruitment or other external marketing activity, but **not** to promote events which are not directly related to IFFTI e.g. symposiums, colloquiums, events, conferences etc.
- Any Member or Non-Member Institute wishing to use the IFFTI logo in any of their externally facing material must seek permission from the IFFTI Secretary by requesting to do so via secretariat@iffiti.org providing a brief explanation as to how the logo is to be
