19. Remarks of Sub-Committee reviewing the application:

(a) Member 1: Ms. Elizabeth Rouse, LCF

I have reviewed the application and recommend Regular Membership.

MMU is one of the leading providers in the UK of fashion design technology and management education. The documentation provides evidence of :

- an appropriate range of subject disciplines offered at undergraduate and postgraduate level;
- good links with industry, including professional training
- research interests of staff
- library resources.

External reviews which are in the public domain have confirmed the quality of the courses, student work and resources.

(b) Member 2: Ms. Sylvie Ebel, IFM

We have received and carefully reviewed the application of Manchester Metropolitan University and recommend Regular Membership.

The two faculties involved in textile and fashion (faculty of food, clothing, hospitality management - department of clothing design and technology + faculty of art & design - department of textile/fashion) cover the three main components of an IFFTI institution: design, management and technology.

The institution, as a UK university, is recognised by the British Department of education and employment and the scores obtained in Quality Assurance Assessment (QAA) and Research Assessment Exercise (RAE) provides evidence of excellent teaching and research.

The library resources related to fashion seem to be wide and accurate.

The links with industry are strong and the wide range of curriculums seem to be adapted to the international context.
