# SHIFTING OF IFFTI SECRETARIAT TO PEARL ACADEMY

- 10.1 The contract for IFFTI accommodation at National Institute of Fashion Technology was to expire on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2006.
- 10.2 At its 14<sup>th</sup> meeting, the Executive Committee had asked the Secretary to obtain offers for providing office accommodation from the following :-
  - (a) National Institute of Fashion Technology
  - (b) Pearl Academy of Fashion
  - (c) Private Builders
- 10.3 The Secretary wrote to National Institute of Fashion Technology and Pearl Academy of Fashion to obtain their concurrence and to provide office accommodation to IFFTI.
- 10.4 In response, NIFT had expressed their inability to renew the arrangement of providing accommodation to IFFTI Secretariat because of space constraint.
- 10.5 On the other hand, Pearl Academy of Fashion agreed to provide 310 square feet furnished accommodation to IFFTI Secretariat at an annual cost of **USD 2400**, as opposed to **USD 6000 per annum** that IFFTI Secretariat had been hitherto paying to NIFT.
- 10.6 The responses received were presented to the Chairperson. After due deliberations, the Chairperson directed that the IFFTI accommodation be shifted to Pearl Academy of Fashion with effect from 01 April 2006.
- 10.7 Accordingly, the IFFTI Secretariat was shifted in the precincts of Pearl Academy on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2006. The new address of IFFTI Secretariat is given below :-

#### <u>Annexure I</u>

# **Design Competition**

The Design Contest is open to students registered in a design related curriculum.

#### ONLY TWO entries total per person will be accepted.

Entries will be accepted in digital format only and must relate to one of the following three categories:

#### Category A: Computer Generated Illustration of Original Fashion Designs

#### Theme: Lifestyle Focus

- i) "On the Board" Board sports including skate, snow and surf, etc.
- ii) "Always Connected" Electronic and digital devices and fashion.
- iii) "Fashion Formal" Dressing up!

**Design Challenge:** Create and illustrate an *original fashion design* inspired by one of the stated themes. Related groupings of up to *3 original fashion designs* are also accepted if presented in a single illustration.

**Entry requirements:** The original design(s) should be presented in the form of a digital illustration. The illustration must communicate the original design(s), but may also include digital photographs, swatches, fabric simulations, and components to enhance the illustration and presentation. *Original fashion design illustrations* may be created using any combination of off-the-shelf software (e.g. Adobe Photoshop/Illustrator) and /or textile/fashion specific CAD software.

#### Category B: Digitally Simulated Textile Design

#### Theme: The Fabric of Fashion

- i) Printed Digital or Traditional
- ii) Woven Fabric or Product
- iii) Knitted Fabric or Product

**Design Challenge:** Create a collection of 3 or more *original printed, woven or knitted textile designs* inspired by the theme "The Fabric of Fashion".

**Entry requirements:** The original textile design collection should be submitted in the form of a digital presentation board. The digital presentation board must include detailed simulations of the original textile designs, but may also include photographs, swatches, texture mapped images, and other components used to communicate scale of the design and enhance the presentation. Presentation boards and Digitally Simulated Textile Designs may be created using any combination of off-the-shelf software (e.g. Adobe Photoshop/Illustrator) and /or textile/fashion specific CAD software.

#### Procedures for submitting entries; Categories A and B:

- 1. All submissions should be presented in the form of a digital illustration or presentation board. Each entry must:
  - (i) Be given a unique title. This will be filled into a form during the submission process and is not required to appear on the illustration.
  - (ii) Be contained in one file, whether it is a single illustration, a grouping or a board presentation.
  - (iii) Be saved for the Windows Platform in a JPG file format.
  - (iv) Be physically sized to fit A6 paper (11.7 x 16.5 inches) in either portrait or landscape orientation.
  - (v) Have an image resolution of 300 dpi.
- 2. Entries will be accepted beginning March 31, 2006 and must be received by June 1, 2006.

#### Category C: Digital Runway

**Design Challenge:** Create a 1 – 4 minute animated multimedia presentation focused on fashion.

*Entry requirements*: The multimedia presentation should be presented in the form of a single file with a unique identifying title.

#### Procedures for submitting entries; Category C:

- 1. All submissions should be presented in digital form and must be self playable. (etc. Real Player, Macromedia Flash
- 2. Entries must be submitted, via the conference website.
- 3. If the presentation file size is too large to upload (**Category C only**) it may be saved to a CD and mailed to:

4. Entries must be received by June 1, 2006.

#### Review and Judging of Entries:

Entries will be judged and award recipients selected during the 2006 IFFTI Conference June 20 – 22, 2006 in Raleigh, North Carolina, USA. Entries will be evaluated on:

- 1. Innovation in Design
- 2. Aesthetics and visual impact
- 3. Quality of Execution and Technique
- 4. Interpretation of Conference and Category Theme
